#### Asthma Medications Should NOT BE STOPPED!!!!

- MAINTENANCE INHALERS should be taken as directed and should be brought with you to the appointment.
- <u>RESCUE INHALERS</u> can be continued but not on the day of the test. Call to reschedule if taken. Bring to appt.
- <u>SHORT TERM INHALERS</u> that are prescribed for infections or acute illnesses will need to be stopped for 2 weeks prior to test.
- THEOPHYLLINE will affect the test. Please notify the allergy department if you are taking this.
